


Middle School

Growing through social interaction, taking on responsibility and moving in the direction of self discipline.

The Middle School - Grades V to VII challenges learners with a broader curriculum to lay the foundation for the High School Academic Programme. Study skills are honed, concepts taught are thoroughly grounded, group work and interaction with classmates cater to growing social awareness. Resourcefulness and commitment to work are encouraged. Induction into the House system helps to inculcate loyalty and team spirit. Use of the well stocked Library at each school for project work enhances habits of self study. The spectrum of extracurricular activities gives scope for talents to surface in Theatre, Music, Art, Dance, Games and Sports. Each student's talent is channelised through a range of hobby clubs. Field trips and excursions are organised.

Test and Examinations now become a part of the assessment methodology and parents are kept appraised of the child's academic progress and are welcome to interact with teachers.

Maximum growth for each learner is the professed motto at this level.



High School

Learning life skills such as-Self confidence, Independence, Leadership, Social Awareness.

The Senior Grades, VIII to X are a veritable beehive of activity. The best possible quality education is provided, taking into consideration, individual needs and aspiration. Suitably high demands are placed on the learners, with a view to stimulating high achievement. Each learner receives personal attention and guidance. Student's work is monitored on a day to day basis through class work, home work and projects. Comprehension of course materials is tested, unit wise through midterm tests and examinations. Progress reports and parent teachers meetings are a regular part of this program. Extra curricular activities still form a part of the curriculum. Students now help in the planning and organization of school celebrations and competitions and are encouraged to test their skills at the Intra School and Inter School Fora. The School cabinet provides a valuable training ground for leadership.

Personality grooming is ensured through workshops on Life Skills, Value Education, Vocational Counselling and Counselling for teenage problems. Resource persons with necessary expertise conduct these programmes. Every attempt is made to ensure our graduates are developed in a 360° manner, they are confident, self-sufficient and focused when they leave the sheltered environment of Presidency.



Senior Secondary School

Choosing the right educational institution for your ward is probably one of the most important decisions you will make. Our prospectus aims to provide the appropriate information to help you make this important decision.

- Curriculum The School offers its students a broad based progressive approach for grades XI & XII. The senior secondary of Presidency School fosters an ambience where students develop into responsible and valued members of the society. The school offers both Science and Commerce streams, and is well equipped with highly qualified and experienced staff to propagate the same.
- Class XI Under Science, the subjects offered are:
 - -English (Compulsory Language)
 - -Mathematics
 - -Physics
 - -Chemistry
 - -Biology/Computer Science/Economics (Elective)

Students can also opt for a Pure Science combination with the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics.

Under Commerce, the subjects offered are:

- -English (Compulsory Language)
- -Accountancy
- -Business Studies
- -Economics
- -Informatics Practice / Mathematics (Elective)
- General Studies Work Experience, Physical and Health Education.

Presidency School has well equipped science and computer laboratories. Well stocked library works as a Resource Centre of reference books, providing young and curious minds with ample opportunity to learn.




Special attention is given to games like basket ball, football, volley ball, badminton & cricket. Other co-curricular activities include music, dance, guitar, keyboard, painting, debating, theatre, yoga and karate are taught by qualified teachers and professionals.

- Furthermore, the school provides students with a plethora of opportunities in the form of participation in several intra and inter-school competitions. This provides an efficient platform for real world exposure.
- Field Trips and Knowledge Sharing:-At Presidency, we believe that knowledge is best acquired when learning happens by seeing and doing. To further their understanding and interest in the subjects, students are taken on field trips to reputed institutes and places which give them good exposure and practice.

The school regularly arranges knowledge sharing programmes by experienced resource people who conduct live sessions for the students. This broadens the students' perspective and exposes them to knowledge beyond their text books and curriculum.

In addition to this, the school hosts other informative events like MUN, Debates, Theatre, Mock Stock Exchange, Panel, Discussions etc.

Admission Process: Admission to Presidency School is open to all. The school prospectus and application forms are available at the school office. Admission is granted on merit and against vacancies. Preference will be given to the students of Class X, presently studying in our CBSE & ICSE schools. Provisional admission is granted to students of Class X based on the Entrance Test conducted in the school. The student is required to score a minimum of 60% in Mathematics and 60% in Science, with an aggregate of 65% in both the subjects.



- Evaluation: The school follows the CBSE prescribed norms of evaluation. Grade XI students appear for Internal Exams. while Grade XII students appear for the CBSE Board Exam.
- Promotion Policy:-Presidency school has established a benchmark in the field of education, encouraging students to perform in the best possible manner. The Promotion Policy is based on the criterion that a student of Grade XI must have an aggregate of 50% in all subjects, with a minimum of 45% marks in the individual subjects offered in the stream. The school requires the students to maintain an attendance of a minimum of 90%.
- Integrated Courses: The School offers integrated additional coaching for admission into courses ike JEE, NEET, etc. to help students prepare for entrance examinations of prestigious institutions. This is offered by *Presidency Academy Center for Excellence (PACE) Overall, the senior secondary of Presidency School strives to bring out well educated and knowledgeable individuals who help in upholding the spirit of the society.
- The school's expectation :- The need for discipline in education is constantly stressed upon in the Presidency Group of Institutions. The senior students are encouraged to be a good role model to their younger counterparts and hence they are expected to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner. Objectionable and irresponsible behaviours will invite strict action. Regular attendance is a must. Students absenting must seek prior permission from the authorities in case of planned absenteeism.
- Students are required to come dressed in the uniforms stipulated by the school, unless otherwise specified.

The Academic Standard of the School
